



STAR READING TARGETS FOR YEARS 7-10

The Accelerated Reader Programme encourages all pupils to read more and is a great way to achieving success where pupils must read within their Book Level Range. All pupils in Years 7-10 are set yearly challenges which are expected to be met. These are the minimum targets each year:

- (Year 10) To have read 6 books and passed 6 quizzes by the summer term (June / July) of that school year. eg: 1 book per half term
- (Years 7 - 9) To have read 12 books and passed 12 quizzes by the summer term (June / July) of that school year. eg: 2 books per half term

Pupils are rewarded in termly assemblies for reaching certain levels:

- 12 Quizzes - Bronze award.
- 18 Quizzes - Silver award.
- 30 Quizzes - Gold award.

For those pupils reading many thousands of words additional awards are presented for:

- 100,000 - 499,999 words – Bronze Wordster award.
- 500,000 - 999,999 words – Silver Wordster award.
- 1 Million+ words - Gold Wordster award plus special recognition from the Head Teacher for joining the Millionaire's Club.

The quizzes can be done in school during pupil's own time but can also be completed at home through the school website on:
