5 PILLARS

ISLAM IS BUILT ON FIVE PILLARS :

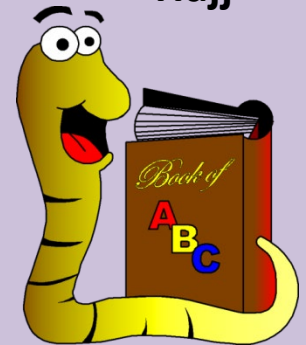
1. The profession that there is no god but ALLAH and that Muhammad is the messenger of ALLAH;
2. Performance of the ritual prayer;
3. Payment of the obligatory charity;
4. The pilgrimage; and
5. The fast of Ramadan.
