Palm Sunday	A man who was crucified for claiming that he was the Son of God.
Jesus	The day in which Jesus rode through the crowds and they waved palm branches at him and lay them at his feet as a sign of respect.
Disciples	The day that Jesus was crucified and died.
Redemption	Jesus died for Christians to be free from sin.
Good Friday	Twelve men who promised to be loyal and faithful to Jesus.
Resurrection	When Jesus rose from the dead.
