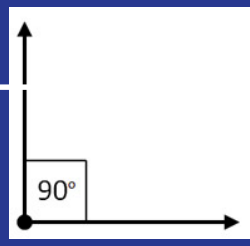




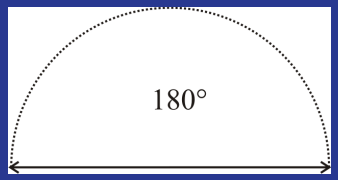
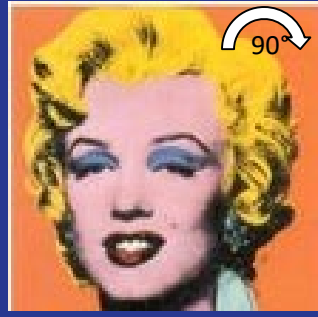
Look at Andy Warhol's repeat pattern of Marilyn Monroe. Consider the other ways he could have created a repeat pattern.

Your task on the other side of this page is to experiment with block print layouts by completing the following tasks:

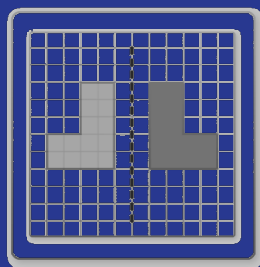
1. Rotate image at a 90° angle.
