Abdication – This means when a leader, like a king, gives up their throne.

Due to the situation in WW1 and lots of people starving in Germany, on 9th November 1918, the Kaiser abdicated. By this point he had lost the support of the army. The Kaiser was replaced by the democratic Weimar Republic.

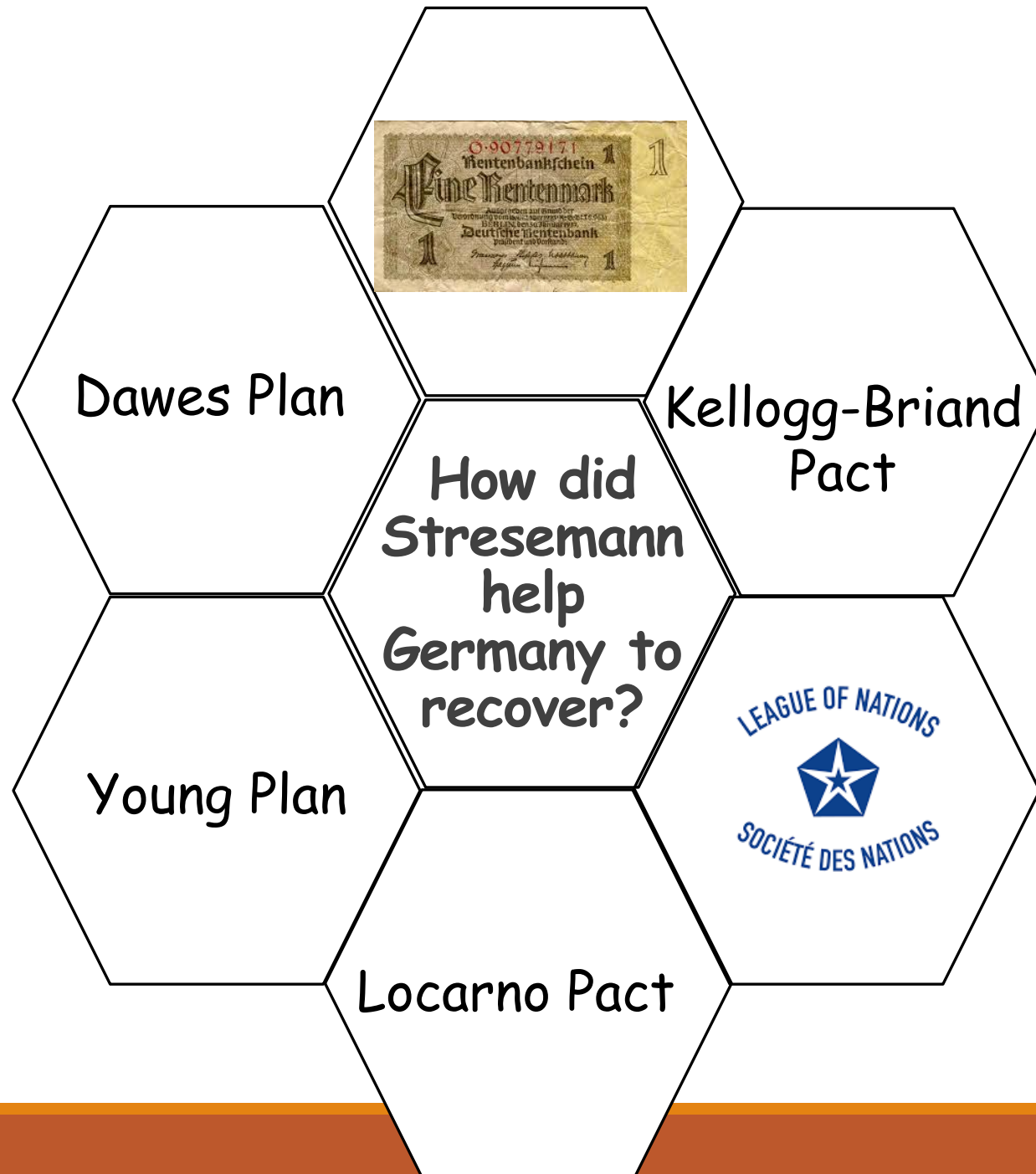

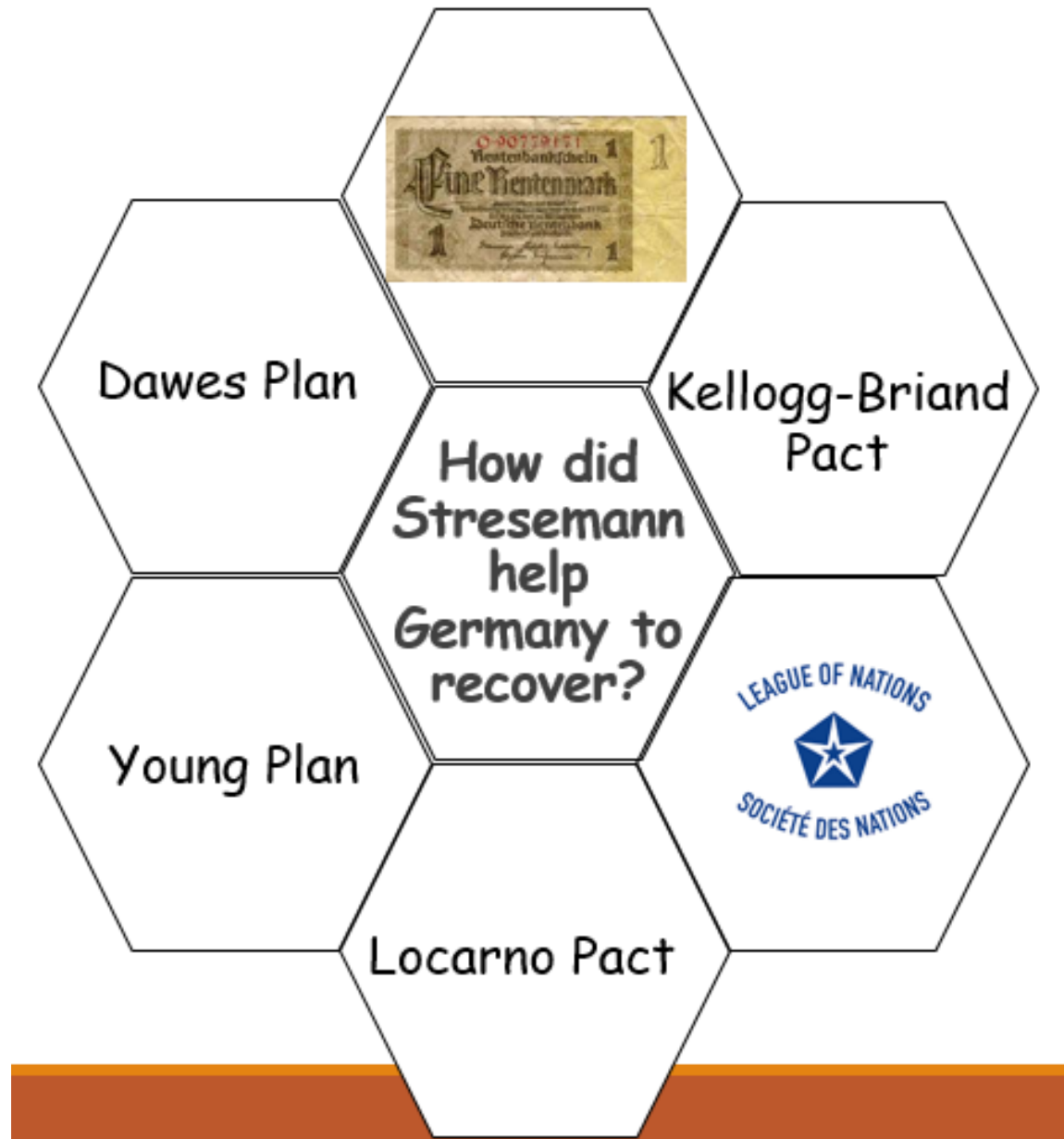
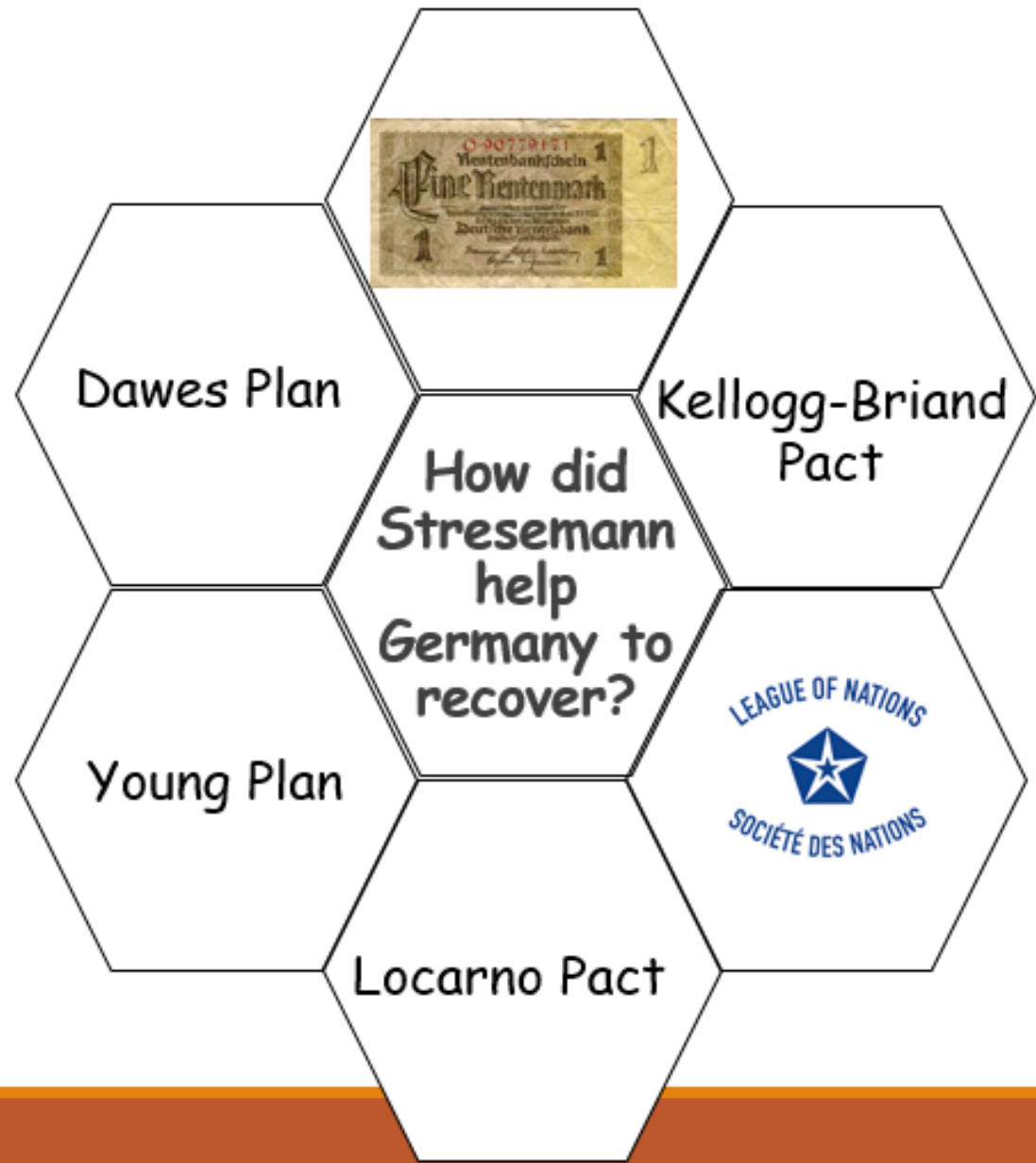


Task 1: Next to the corresponding box can you explain how the picture/phrase links to the recovery of the German economy.
