Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you that the Year 11 mock exams begin on **Thursday 23rd November, and will end on Tuesday 13th December.**

Following the changes to exams in previous years, mock exams are more important than ever. It is vital that pupils are able to sit a full set of mock exams because exams will play a crucial part in improving pupils' exam technique, building confidence and allowing teachers to identify gaps in knowledge which can then be addressed in lessons and in after school boosters.

Pupils have been given a mock exam timetable which informs them of the dates and times of their mock exams. A copy of this timetable is available on the academy's website.

Pupils have had an assembly explaining how to effectively revise for exams as well as the importance of mock exams. Your child has also been issued with a revision timetable so they can plan adequate revision in the lead up to, and around, the mock exams. Their subject teachers will be supplying them with revision work, but we must highlight the importance of independent study. We recommend that Year 11 students spend at least 2 hours per evening on their revision. More information regarding how pupils can revise and how parents can support their child at home can be found in our Autumn Newsletter available on the academy's website.

The academy recognises that high quality revision is extremely important in ensuring that students are well equipped with the skills and knowledge for their final exams as well boosting self-confidence and reducing stress.
